



Research in Context

Visit the Gale resource page by visiting the Virtual Library at http://www.rainbowschools.ca/virtual_library/. Follow the Gale Databases link on the bottom left of the homepage. At home you will require a password – check with your teacher or library.



Enter your search term here, or browse by topic.

Your search results will look like this:



Each results page contains a topic overview.

Results are sorted by publication type and include reference material, biographies, images, magazine and newspaper articles, and video files. Click publication type to read articles.

Articles are coded for levels: Easy: ●
 Intermediate: ■
 Senior: ▲

A number of tools are provided to help you manage your documents including a citation maker, the option to email or print the document, the ability to highlight text or download as an MP3 file. New this year is the option to save to your Google Drive as described below.

Related subjects are provided to aid in further research.

Gale and Google Compatability

The majority of the Gale databases are fully integrated with the Google platform. This means you are able to save articles directly to your Google Drive. In addition, teachers may send articles to their Google Classroom.

Click the "Download" option found in the Tool Box beside the article. You will be prompted to sign in to your Google account, then select "Save to Google Drive"

Teachers may send articles to their Google Classroom. Click the classroom icon, then choose the classroom you wish to send it to.

Teachers may also search for articles based on curriculum standards. Follow the prompts to search for articles relating to Ontario curriculum strands. The database **Canada in Context** has the most relevant information as it is devoted to Canadian content.
